Out of concern for our employee's well-being, CANTEX has decided to temporarily shut down our Aurora Ohio facility for two weeks effective Thursday evening, March 26th. These employees were not confirmed positive for COVID-19 by means of a test, but we believe their physician's diagnoses were serious enough to warrant the shutdown.

The customer orders currently serviced by the Aurora distribution center will be moved to the Auburndale, Florida or Mineral Wells, Texas distribution centers. We anticipate that most customers will not see an interruption in service during the shutdown, but we certainly cannot guarantee this situation will not create any delays.
